## Did You Know?

Heyward Street United Methodist Church dates all the way back to 1909. That year, J.A. Elkins organized a Sunday school in a small four-room frame school building. In 1910, Waverly Methodist Episcopal Church was formed with a membership of 15. By 1911, Waverly ME Church had 74 members. In November 1936, the church purchased land at Heyward and Queen Streets and renamed the church, Wesley Memorial, in honor of the 200<sup>th</sup> anniversary of Wesley's awakening at Aldersgate.
